Workshop Descriptions

- **You and Your Horse:** On-horse training for youth who are looking to enhance their relationship and performance with their horse. Parents may also attend to observe and learn alongside the youth.
- **Performance Against the Standard (PAS):** This workshop will help youth and parents learn more about what a PAS judge is looking for when evaluating them for state fair qualification.
- **Attire & Showmanship:** Figuring out what attire to wear when can be challenging. This workshop will help youth and parents learn about attire and showmanship, including the differences between Western and English.
- **Trail and Trail-in-Hand:** This workshop will help youth understand the differences between trail and trail-in-hand and teach them some techniques to improve their and their horse's performance in each class.
