We are seeking enthusiastic 4-H members and young alumni to serve as camp counselors for Junior and Senior Shooting Sports Camps!

Current 4-H'ers will be eligible to be camp counselors for Junior Shooting Sports Camp June 25th-28th

arriving on the afternoon of June 25th. Youth must be at least 14 years old as of January 1, 2020. Any youth wishing to assist at camp in any capacity will need to complete the camp counselor application and training; this includes Shooting Sports Junior Leaders as they do also have cabin responsibilities. If you are serving as a camp counselor in your county, you will still need to complete this application.

Alumni are encouraged to apply to be camp counselors for Senior Shooting Sports Camp July 18th-24th, arriving on the afternoon of July 18th. You will be required to complete the enclosed application, training and appropriate background checks and become an approved screened volunteer in your county.

All counselors will be required to complete the training requirements as outlined in the position description. You will be responsible for completing this training through your home county. You are responsible for contacting your local 4-H professional to discuss training requirements. We will be communicating with your county 4-H professional to confirm successful completion.

What do I do as a Shooting Sports Camp Counselor? Serving as a camp counselor at shooting sports camp is no different than at any other camp. You are expected to serve as role models for your campers, supervise campers, provide good cabin management, participate fully in activities, keep track of campers, lead songs, games, etc. and assist with other camp activities as needed. At Shooting Sports Camp, campers participate in discipline specific sessions with adult instructors. You will be assigned a discipline and will assist the adult instructors as needed. If you are a trained Shooting Sports Junior Leader, we will do our best to assign you to the discipline you are trained. This is not guaranteed as all disciplines will need help. Final counselor selections will be announced after all interviews are completed and is contingent on successful completion of counselor training.

We hope you will consider applying to be a camp counselor for Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports Camps. These camps provide youth a great learning experience, but we think they are also just a lot of fun! It takes great volunteers to make these possible, and that includes exceptional camp counselors.
