Use the US Route 42 exit (#79) from Interstate 70. On US 42, go south toward London, Ohio. Go west on US Route 40. Proceed to the first traffic light and turn right onto St Rt 38 north. Cross over the freeway and turn left at first road (Arbuckle Road). Proceed about 800 feet to the entrance to the Conservation Area parking lot on the right. Drive up gravel drive to cabin.
