Different species require various procedures to break dormancy and will be given the proper amount of time to achieve maximum germination.

Results will be emailed in the months of February or March

SAMPLE SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Please use these guidelines for submitting a sample.

1. Samples should be collected when seed is **mature**.
 - a. Fully developed seed will be hard not soft.
2. Collect **entire seedheads**.
 - a. Depending on species 10 to 30 seedheads are needed to have enough seed for a proper screening.
3. Sample should be fresh,
 - a. Mail immediately or let air dry under cool dry conditions in an open **PAPER** bag for 2–4 weeks.
4. Do **NOT** collect or store in **PLASTIC**
5. Samples should be carefully packaged and shipped **early in the week** to avoid weekend layovers during which the sample will deteriorate.
6. Be sure to include sample documentation and background information.

Examples of Mode of Action: Trade Names

Glyphosate: Roundup, Touchdown, etc.

ALS: FirstRate, Pursuit, etc.

PPO: Flexstar, Cobra, etc.
