


#### **Department Chair**

In 1967, Ralph Bender was entering his nineteenth year as Department Chair, a position he would hold for 30 years.

There are 12 faculty on staff in 1967: Ralph Bender, Ralph Woodin, Willard Wolf, Richard Wilson, Carlton Johnson, Gilbert Guiler, Robert McCormick, Leon Boucher, Robert E. Taylor, Clarence Cunningham, David Jenkins and James Hensel. New faculty are added throughout the decade: John T. Starling (1967), J. Robert Warmbrod (1967), Jerry Halterman (1968), Charles Lifer (1969), Joel Magisos (1969), David McCracken (1970), Richard Young (1971), Wesley Budke (1971), N. L. McCaslin (1971), Robert E. Norton (1971), Seifried Bruny (1971), L. H. Newcomb (1973), Larry Erpelding (1973), Norman Stanley (1973), Joe Gliem (1974), Dewey Adams (1976), Odell Miller (1976), and Raymond Miller (1976). Woodin and Wolf retire in 1973, Hensel leaves the department in 1964, and McCormick, Cunningham, Erpelding, and Young leave in 1977. This leaves 23 faculty on staff in 1977.

## **Graduate Studies**

The department graduated 295 Master's students and 118 PhD students during this time period. Bender, Cunningham, Warmbrod, Woodin, Wilson, McCormick, Taylor, and Wolf all served as doctoral advisors during this decade. Changes had been made to the Master's degree requirements in the previous decade which had allowed both thesis and nonthesis Master's degrees. This became a popular option and 226 non-thesis Master's degrees were completed in this decade.












## **CURRICULUM 1967-1977**

New certification standards went into effect in January, 1972 which included the preparation of prospective teachers in ten specific agricultural taxonomies: Agricultural Production, Animal Production and Management (Animal Care), Farm Management, Agricultural Industrial Equipment and Service, Agricultural Products Processing, Horticulture, Agricultural Resources conservation, Agricultural Environmental Management, Forestry, and Agricultural Business, Supply and Service.

The Agricultural Technical Institute, headed by department alum Jerry Halterman began operations in 1972. During the early years of ATI, the department held a major role in the development of a quality teaching program. Leon Boucher gave teaching methods, and classroom and laboratory organization and planning.





## **DEPARTMENT LOCATIONS 1967-1977**







Agricultural Administration Building





