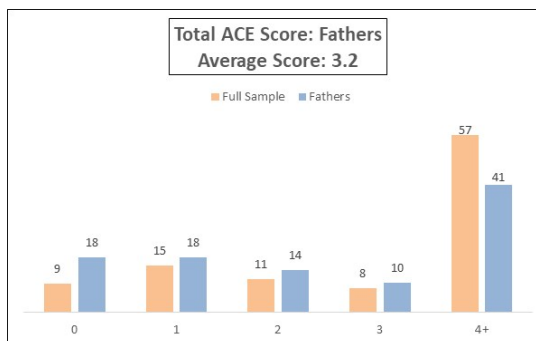
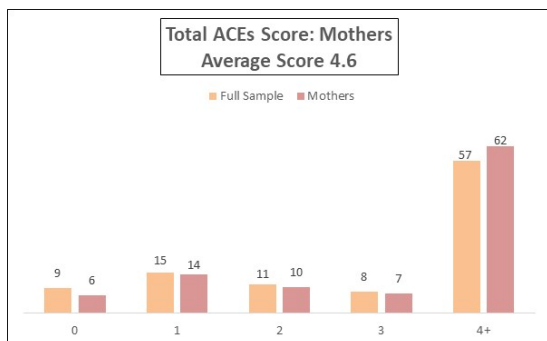

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) in Parents



► Overall, 57% of parents have 4 or more ACEs, with an average score of 5.6

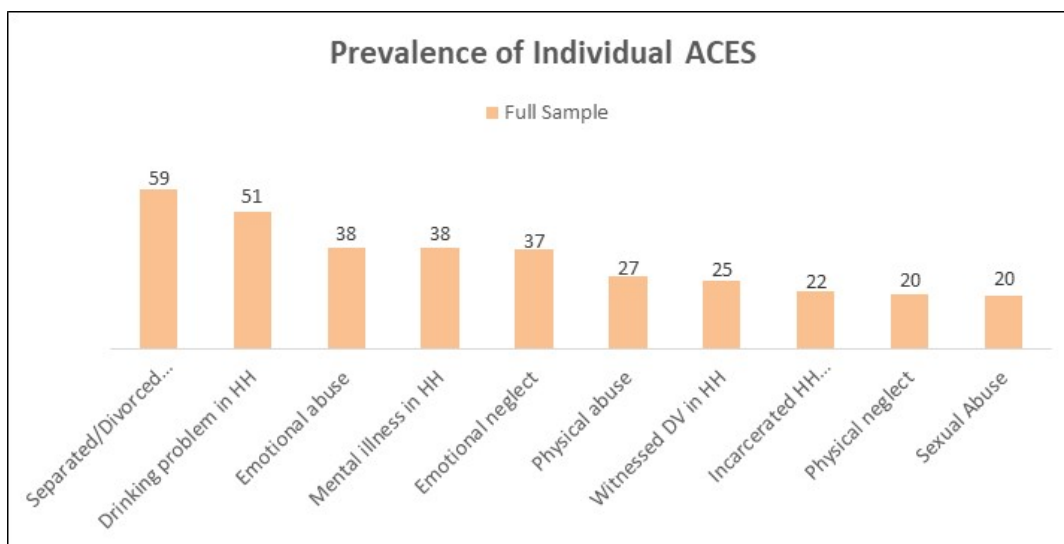


62% of mothers have 4 or more ACEs



41% of fathers have 4 or more ACEs

► OhioSTART mothers are significantly more likely to have higher ACE scores compared to fathers ($p=0.00$)

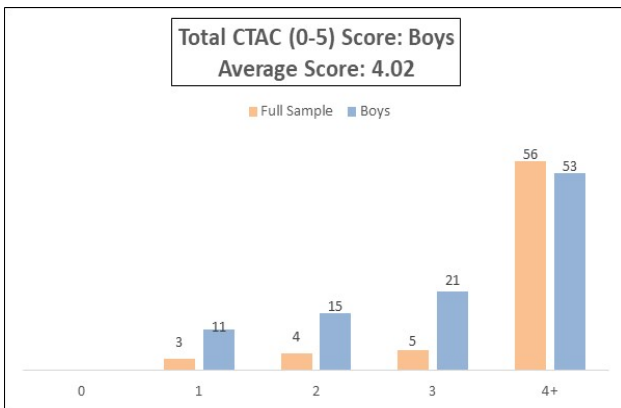
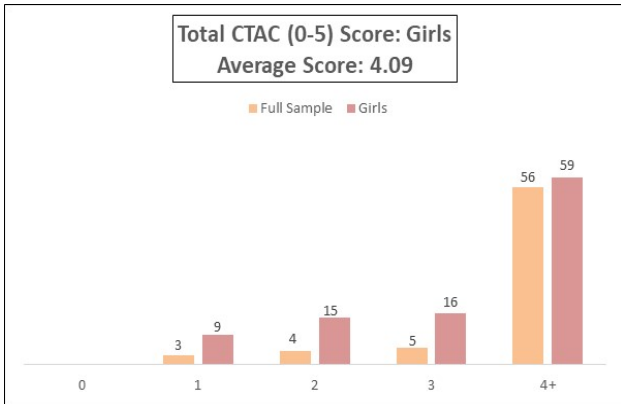

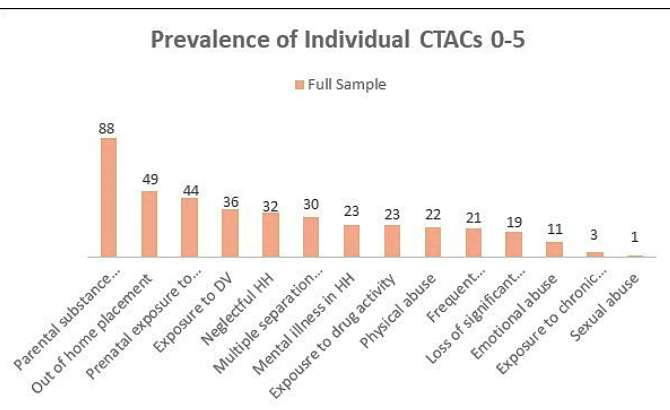
Ages 0-5



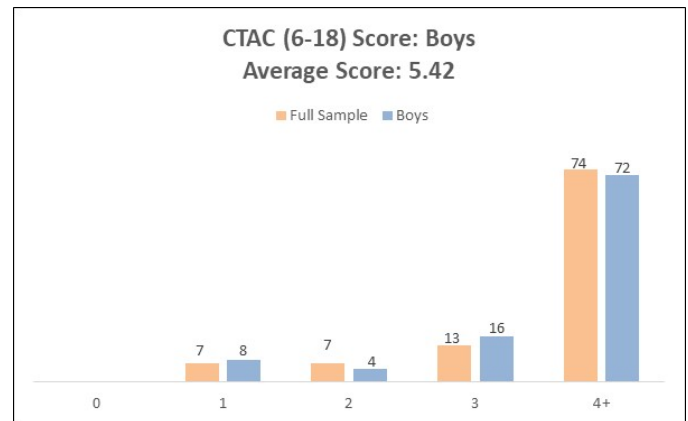
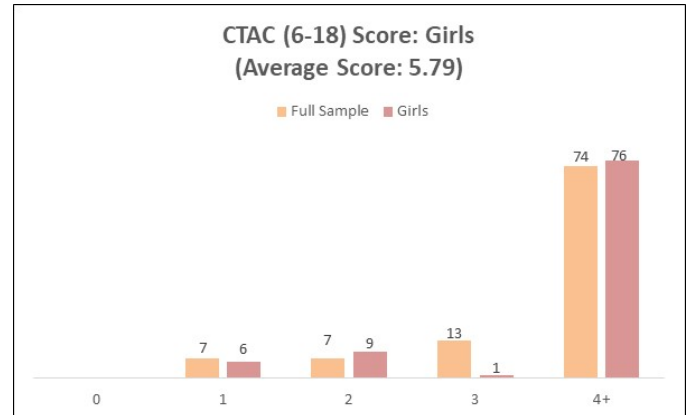
► Overall, 56% of younger children have CTAC scores of 4 or more, with an average score of 4.0

♀ **59% of younger girls have CTAC scores of 4 or more**

♂ **53% of younger boys have CTAC scores of 4 or more**



Ages 6-18



► Overall, 74% of older children have CTAC scores of 4 or more, with an average score of 5.6

♀ **76% of older girls have CTAC scores of 4 or more**

♂ **72% of older boys have CTAC scores of 4 or more**
