

Install Cisco AnyConnect Client on MacOS

You can use your Mac computer to securely connect to the UCM network from anywhere in the world. All you need is the Cisco AnyConnect Virtual Private Network app, which is easy to install. Simply follow these instructions.

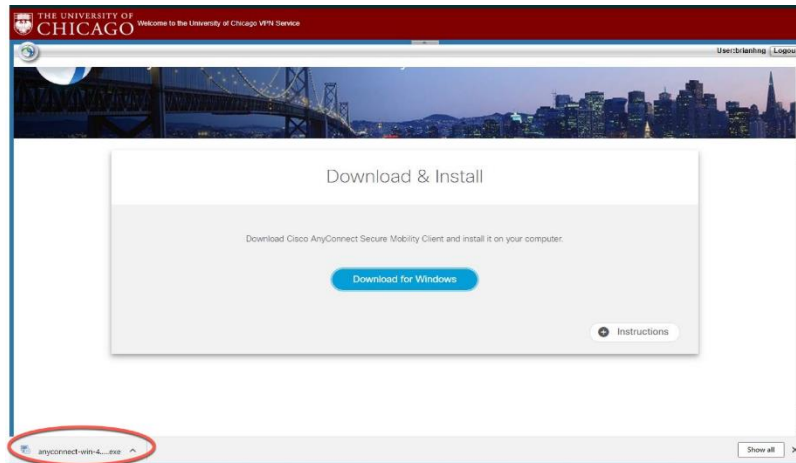
If you cannot successfully install the app, contact the UCMIT Service Desk for assistance.

Requirements: MacOS version 10.12, 10.13, 10.14, 10.15. An active Internet connection.

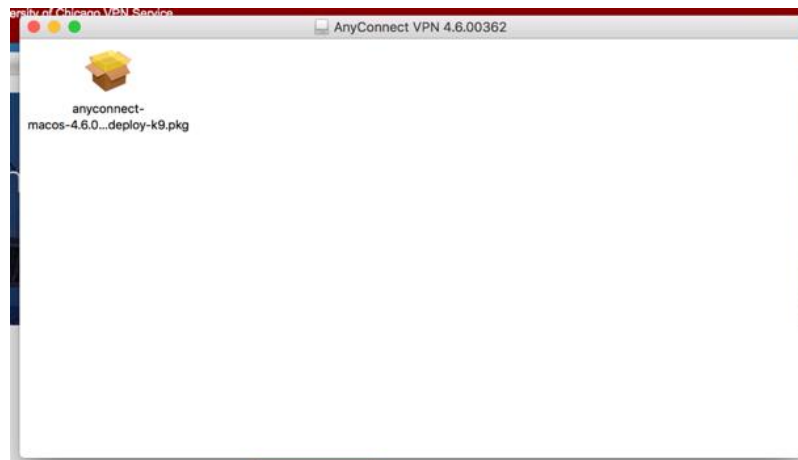
1. Launch a web browser and go to <https://webvpn.uchospitals.edu>.
2. Log in with your **UCHAD username** and **password**.
3. Upon clicking **Login**, a signal will be sent to your cellphone for **2FA authorization**. Click **approve** on your cellphone.
4. After log in you will be presented with a Login banner, click **Continue**.



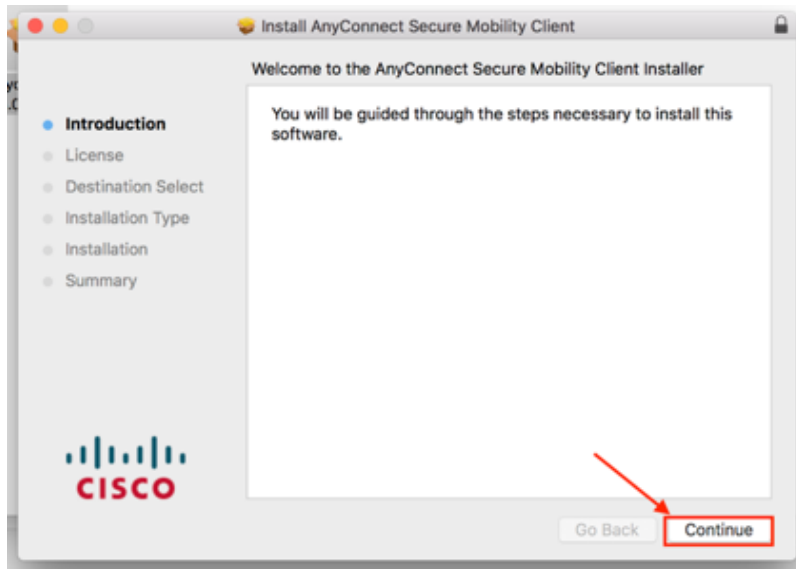
5. You will be presented with the client download screen. Click on **Download for MacOS** link to download the software. Depending on your browser configuration you can run the installer from the Downloads bar.
 - If your browser has the option to directly “open” the file, choose that.



- If there is no Downloads bar, navigate to where the file was downloaded and run the installer.

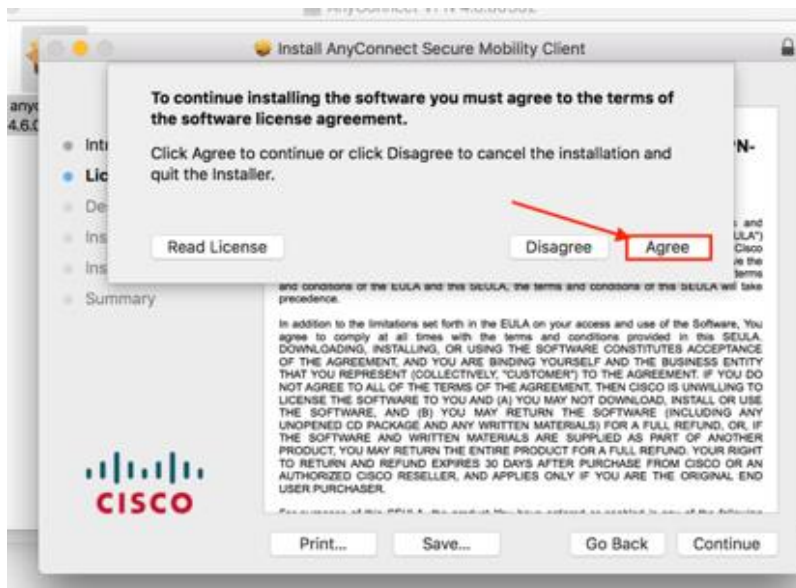


6. Follow through the installer instructions after the welcome screen. Click **Continue**.

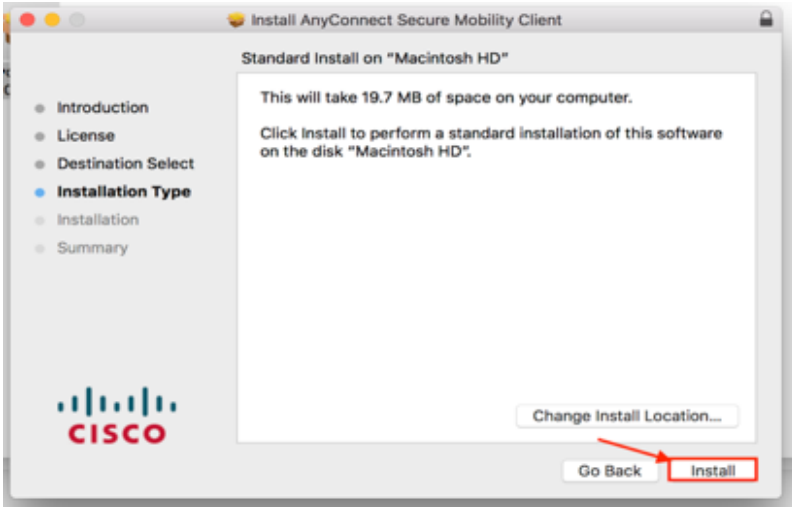


7. Read the agreement, then click **Continue**.

8. Click **Agree** to continue or **Disagree** to cancel installation.



9. Click **Install**.

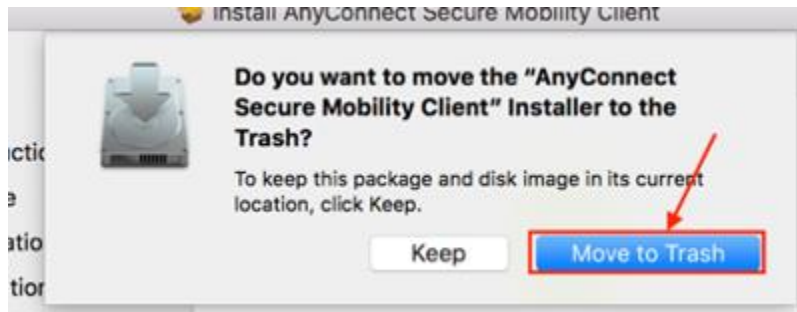


10. Press finger onto fingerprint reader or click **Use Password** to enter your credentials.

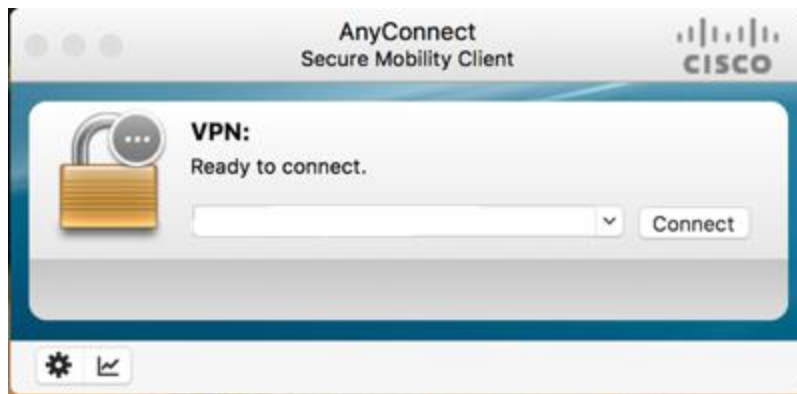


11. Click **Close** to finish installation.

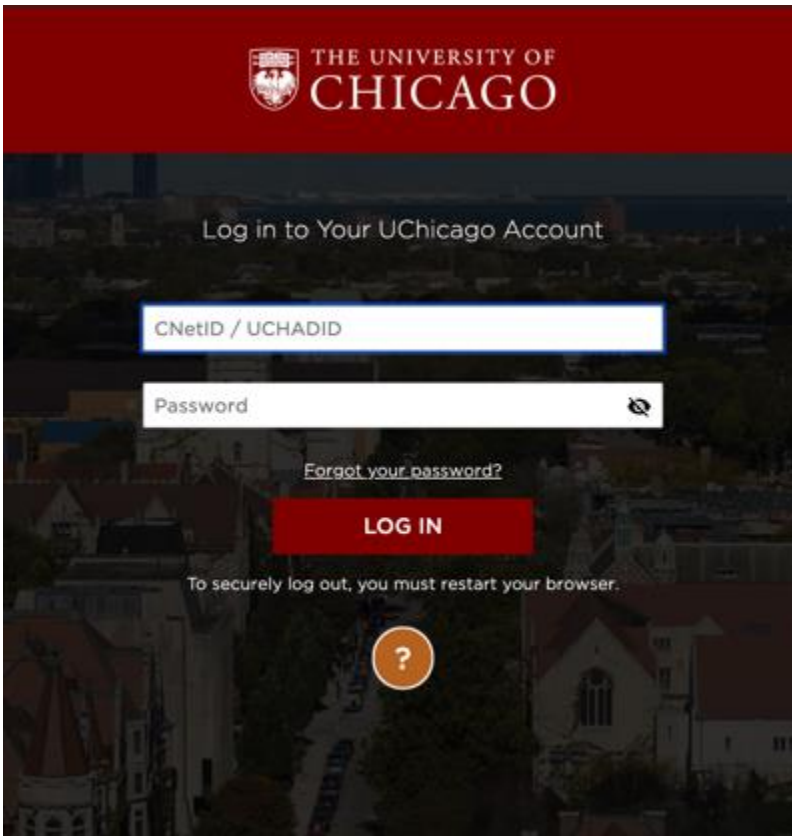
12. There is no need to keep the installer, click **Move to Trash**.



13. Launch the Cisco AnyConnect program from your **Launchpad**.

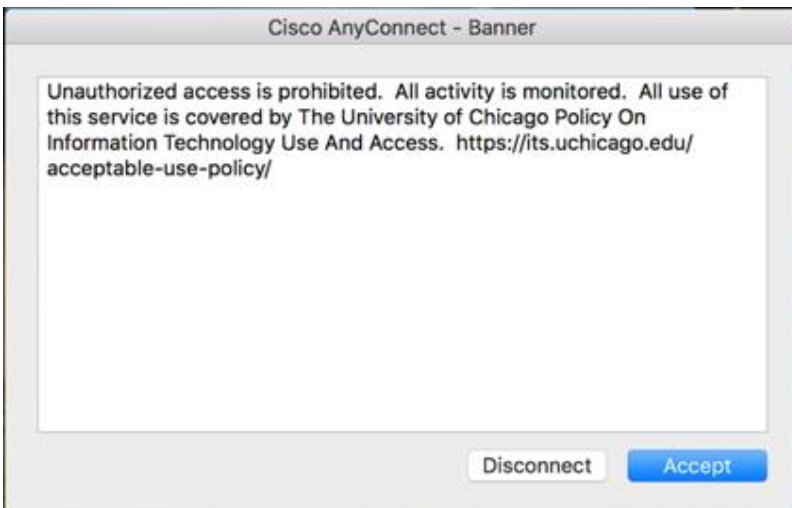


14. At the credential pop up window will appear. Enter your **UCHAD username** and **password** and click **Ok**.



Note: You may get prompted for additional 2FA login. Please select the method for the second verification process.

15. At the welcome window, read the Acceptable Use Policy and click **Accept** to continue.



16. A notification will appear when connected successfully. The AnyConnect application icon will be visible in the menu tray in the top right corner.



17. To disconnect from VPN open the AnyConnect application by selecting the AnyConnect icon at the bottom dock, then click **Disconnect**.
