The Data Science for Energy and Environmental Research program, supported by an NSF Research Traineeship grant, **provides funding and resources for UChicago graduate students doing data-driven work in environmental areas**, with a special emphasis on research that touches on energy, food, and water (including climate and ecological systems). Our goal is to build community among students and to provide training in computational and statistical tools in order to enrich students' primary thesis work.
