Apply now for an expenses-paid externship to the 2023 Annual Meeting of the American Psychoanalytic Association (APsaA), www.apsa.org.

Date and location: January 31 – February 5, 2023, Hilton Midtown Hotel, New York City

This externship provides a unique opportunity to discover the world of psychoanalysis in all its aspects: as a theory of mind, as a method of interpretation across the disciplines, and as a clinical practice.

Eight students will be chosen to attend the Annual Meeting of the American Psychoanalytic Association offered in-person from January 31 to February 5, 2023, at the Hilton Midtown in New York City. **Registration fees and hotel rooms are covered as part of the externship along with transportation and food stipends and extern-mentor events.**

Students will be able to attend all parts of the scientific program, including plenary presentations, featured panels, and smaller discussion groups and workshops on an extraordinary range of topics including: gender and sexuality, addictions, child and adolescent analysis, ethics, psychoanalysis in the social sciences and humanities, and research and empirical studies. Students will be assigned mentors to assist with registration and to serve as their guides during the meetings.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Undergraduate Juniors and Seniors (in any field) with a serious interest in psychoanalytic studies.
- Graduate students (in any field) with a serious interest in psychoanalytic studies.

Application requirements:

1. your current resume
2. an unofficial copy of your academic transcript
3. a letter of recommendation by a professor or other academic advisor
4. a two-page essay on the question: "How do you imagine psychoanalysis might impact your field of study?" (maximum 750 words)
