There is a block of 20 rooms at the Golden Hotel for \$199/night available Wednesday, Thursday and Friday nights. The other hotel within walking distance is Table Mountain Inn but it was nearly full as of March 1. They may have a few rooms available, but could not offer a block. ### **Airport Transportation**

Allow 45-60 minutes by car to and from Denver International Airport during non-rush hours. Shuttles typically range from \$45-\$100 one-way depending on the type of service.

### **Visitor Parking and Driving Directions to Golden**

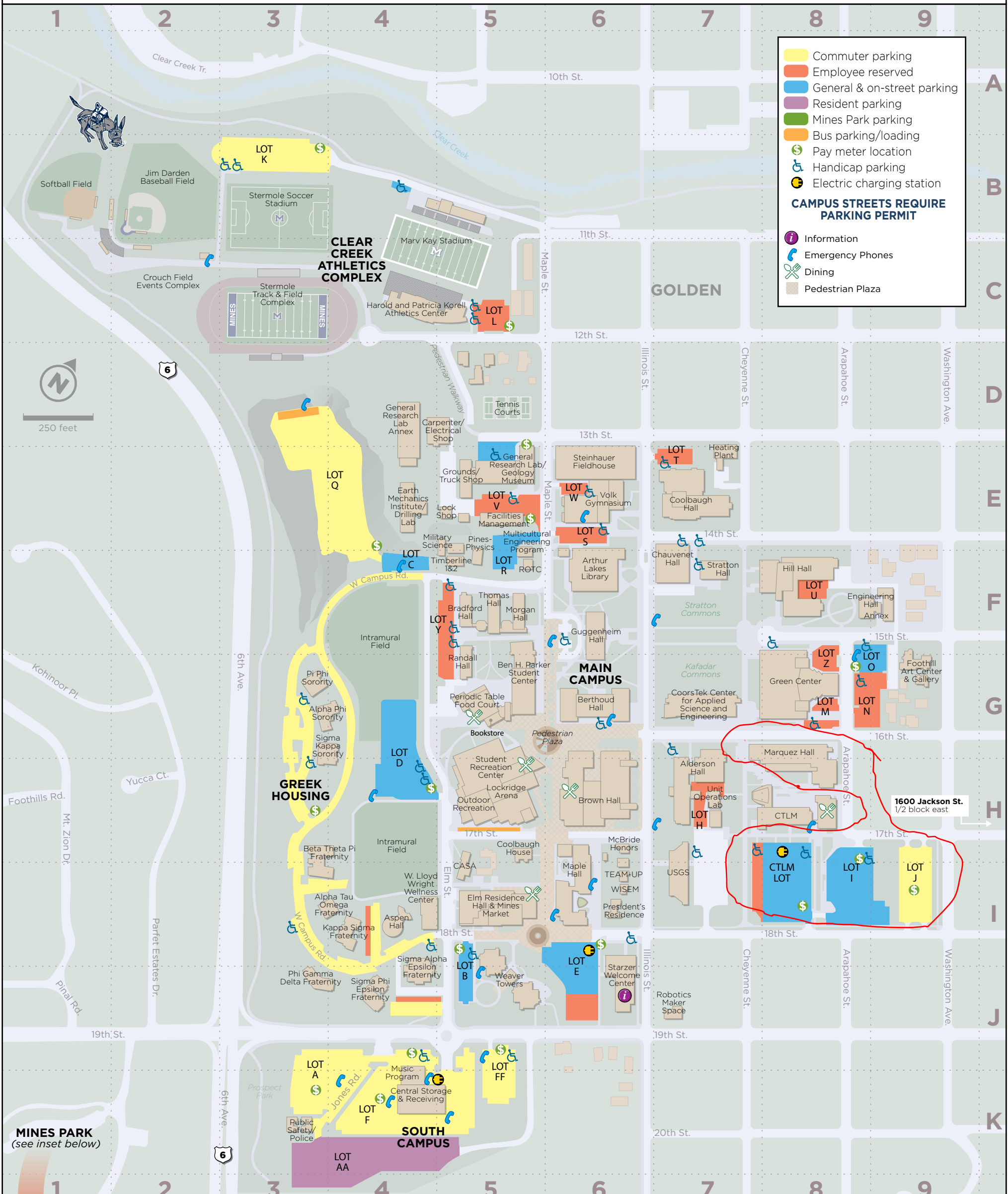
