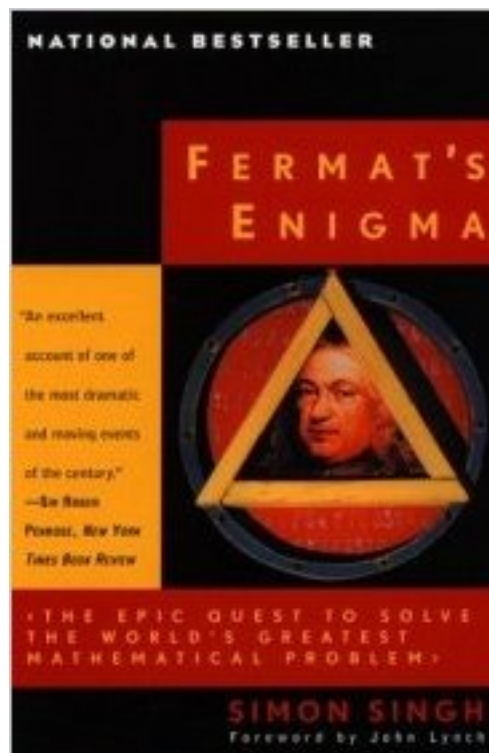


MAMS Math - Juniors Summer Reading 2019
