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Mass Academy Residency Requirement

Massachusetts Academy of Math and Science (“Mass Academy”) is open to students who are Massachusetts residents. Students who are not Massachusetts residents are not eligible to attend Mass Academy.

An applicant’s parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must have established residency in Massachusetts prior to the applicant applying to Mass Academy. During the application process, the family must submit the three proofs of residency detailed in the table below.

An admitted student’s parent(s) or legal guardians(s) must also maintain residency in Massachusetts throughout the student’s attendance at Mass Academy, from the date the student enters school for their junior year through graduation senior year. The parent/guardian must notify the school immediately of any change in address and provide the three proofs of residency detailed in the table below.

Proof of Residency Table

All applicants must submit at least three proofs of residency, one from each column below. Documents must be pre-printed with the name and address of student’s parent or legal guardian.
